**Voting in Your Precinct on Election Day**

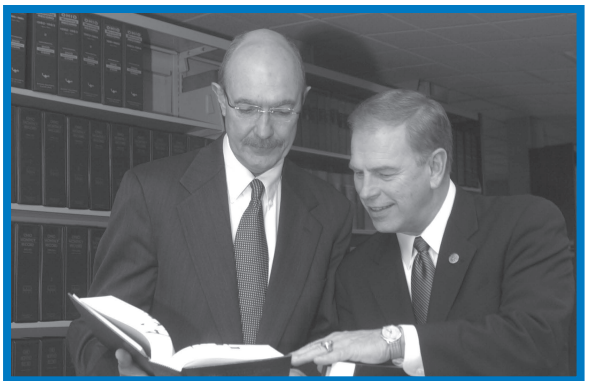
Go to your correct precinct. If you do not know your precinct, call the Board of Elections at 592-3201. As a precaution, take some identification to your voting location. A driver's license, a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check or government document showing your name and address will work.

**Voting Absentee**

This can be done by mail or in person at the Board of Elections, located at 15 South Court St., Room 130, Athens, 45701. Your absentee ballot must be received back at the Board of Elections on Election Day by 7:30 p.m. Tuesday, November 2nd. Having it postmarked will not make it count, unless you are overseas. You or a family member may turn your ballot into the Board of Elections office in person up to 7:30 p.m. on Election Day. Do not take your absentee ballot to your polling location, because it will not be counted if you do. You may also vote absentee in person at the Board of Elections until 4:00 p.m. on Monday, November 1st, and vote in a voting booth.

**Provisional Voting**

If you are registered to vote somewhere in Ohio and have moved, but didn't change your address with a Board of Elections, you can still vote. You can go to the Board of Elections, located at 15 South Court, Room 130, Athens, 45701 and change your address and vote then and there any day between now and Election Day. Be careful to complete the outside envelope correctly and sign your name (do not print) where requested. Also be sure to complete the voter registration form they give you. You can vote provisionally on Election Day by going to your new precinct. Call 592-3201 or Democratic Party Headquarters at 740-594-VOTE (8683) to figure out where you need to go to vote.

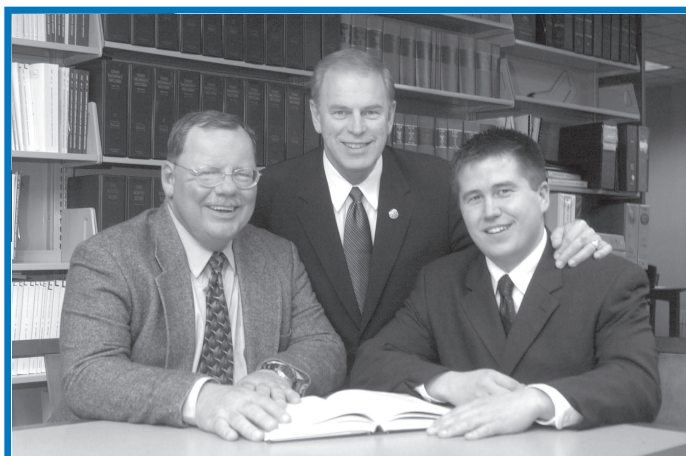

## What do I need to know if I am voting by punch card?

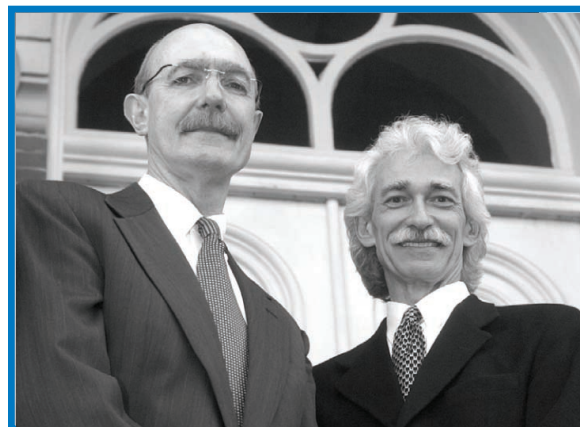
Remember Florida! We can't be defeated by hanging chad. To cast your vote when using a punch card, remember these three tips:

1. Double-check that you are punching the right hole. If you make a mistake, you can always ask for a new ballot, up to three times.
2. Punch through your ballot completely.
3. If required, don't forget to sign your ballot.

It's as easy as 1-2-3!

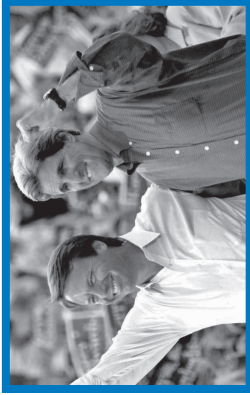
## Do not allow anyone to trick you out of voting!

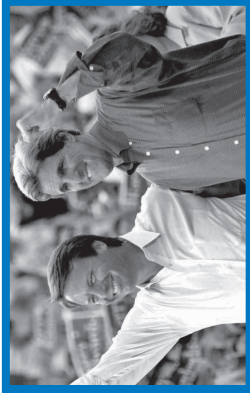
